

Workshop on Personality Development and Art of Positivism






On the occasion, various activities were organized such as:


The Rules were:


Report on Punjabi Maah Celebration (17-11-2021)




**Extension Lecture on Effects of Depression on Adolescents' Health

At last, she said it's not impossible to deal with such students but it needs a positive attitude and lot of patience to develop such children.
