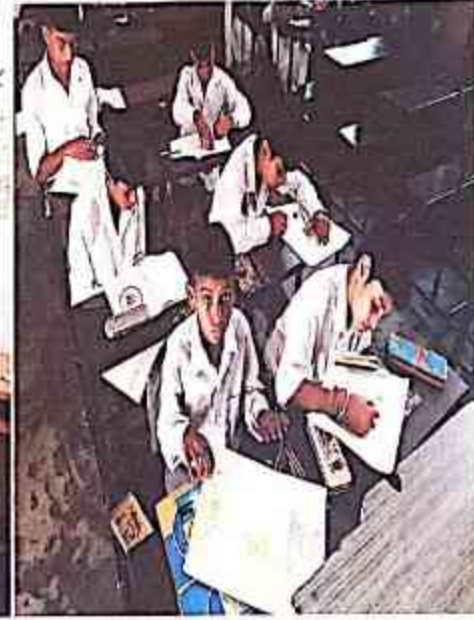

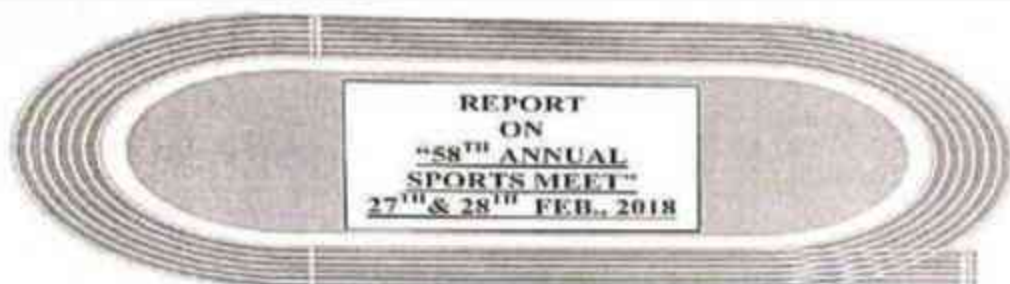

Report on the Celebration of National Voters Day






MISSION TANDRUST PUNJAB ON YOGA WORKSHOP (12-01-2021)

Report On International Yoga Day


