## 2. **INVOLVEMENT IN THE IN-HOUSE CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT**

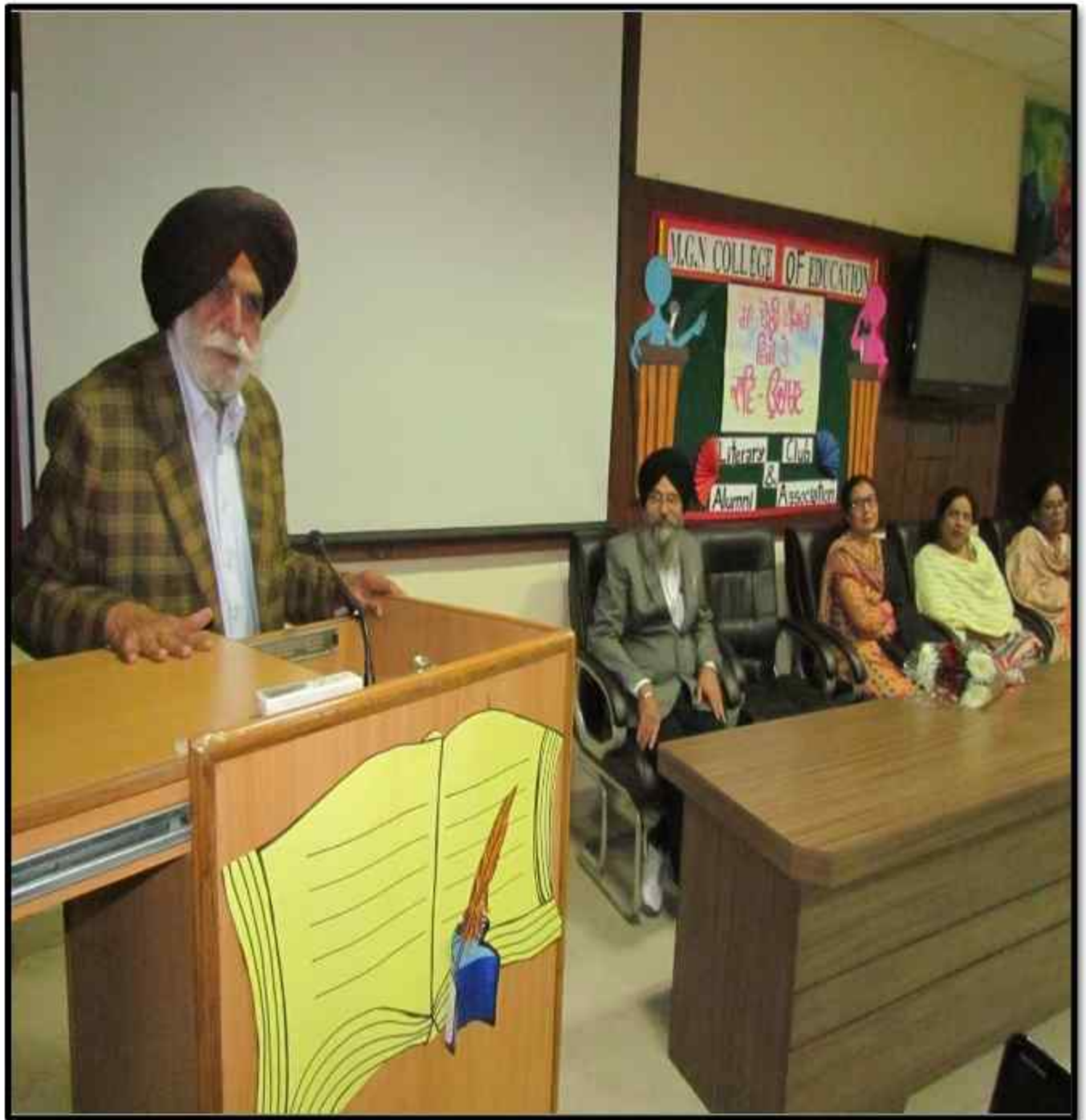
